Recommended Readings from Rev. Geordie Zeigler

For those who want to dig deeper on our summer theme of "The Country of Grace":

- 1. Trinitarian Grace and Participation:** an entry into the theology of Thomas F. Torrance by Geordie W. Zeigler (Fortress, 2017). This book actually provides the form and content of our series this summer. I'll be preaching through the introduction and the first two chapters. It is a modified version of my thesis, so pretty academic, but accessible if you have lots of patience and a dictionary nearby!
- 2. The Mediation of Christ** by T.F. Torrance (Helmets & Howard Publishers; Revised edition (July 1, 1992)). This is the book that rocked my theological world and enlarged my vision of the gospel of grace.
- 3. Unspoken Sermons** by George MacDonald (Series 1, 2, 3). A little-known fact is that C.S. Lewis considered George MacDonald his theological mentor. MacDonald's book of 30 sermons is as ingenious as it is relentless in its presentation of a Father God who is committed to nothing less than full communion and union with us. It is terribly good news (once you read it, you'll understand that last phrase!) You can also listen to the sermons for free with the phone app 'audio books'.

A donor has provided funds to purchase two of the books listed above to accompany Rev. Geordie Zeigler's sermon series this summer. Look for The Mediation of Christ and Unspoken Sermons in the church library this Sunday.
